Dear Parent / Guardian:

We are pleased to inform you that AYTTO has started its Saturday Table Tennis Academy. This program is open for children that have already exhibited a strong interest in learning more about the Olympic Sport of Table Tennis. This program will be held each Saturday at IS 126 on 80 Catherine Street in Manhattan.

AYTTO is a non profit organization will run the Saturday Table Tennis Academy in partnership with IS 126. The goal of the academy is to provide extra table tennis and life skills instruction to school aged students already enrolled in our lunch time or after school programs and to those students who do not participate in our programs but wish to learn from an expert coach in a group environment. The Academy will focus on building table tennis skills around a proven curriculum, including physical conditioning, agility exercises, teamwork, character development and fair play.

The Saturday Academy also serves as a platform into the national and international sport of table tennis. For those students who are interested, there will be opportunities to meet and compete against others as a team in nationally sanctioned events. Table Tennis is an Olympic Sport. It is also a sport that is played in hundreds of colleges throughout the country. The Saturday Academy will expose you and your child to this wonderful life time sport and the opportunities that are available.

Provided below are a couple of important details concerning the program:

- Dates: Saturday's between 10/4 to 6/30 (except 11/29, 12/27 and such other days as notified in advance).
- Times: 12 Noon to 3 PM.
- Location: IS 126 School Cafeteria.
- Eligibility: Students enrolled in AYTTO after school or in school programs.
- Costs: \$75 per trimester (Fall, Winter, Spring – Approximately 10 sessions each. Note the Saturday Academy is offered at no charge to all students enrolled in an established AYTTO or Affiliate Program (visit www.aytto.org for a list).
- Equipment: No charge. However we strongly encourage your child purchase a good racquet which we can sell at www.zypsports.com or through one of our coaches for a discounted price of \$20).
- Transportation to and from venue: Responsibility of parent / child.
- Enrollment limited to the first 16 student applications (a waiting list will be created thereafter).
