Receiving accolades from parents, principals, and after school directors, AYTTO is the only not for profit organization in the United States that coordinates school table tennis programs for disadvantaged urban youth. Through table tennis we link both sports learning and social interaction - connecting enrolled students to a lifetime sport, to one another, and to the school day.

Our programs do more than just provide participants with an outstanding opportunity to exercise and stay fit. Parents and teachers are informing us that they see the positive results in the children we teach. Perhaps this is because our highly experienced coaches teach leadership, teamwork and fair play. It may also be that table tennis is the right side of exciting research by leading Neuroscientists which link fast precision activities like table tennis to improved mental alertness over time.

Last year we provided invaluable programming to over 800 children, many of whom play no other sport. In 2011 our vision is to provide the following:

- A. After School Table Tennis Programs – AYTTO works closely with fourteen New York City and Boston Public schools to provide dedicated after school table tennis instruction. These schools pay 50% of our coaching costs. More schools wish to join.
- B. Middle School Table Tennis League – AYTTO in partnership with the New York City Department of Education and Sports & Arts In Schools Foundation plans to run a large interscholastic middle school league involving sixteen schools and over two hundred students.
- C. Saturday Table Tennis Academy and Academics: - AYTTO's successful Saturday Academy provides children with an opportunity to experience expert table tennis instruction needed to master many new skills. Sports and Academics working side by side.
